



## The Maggie Marcopul Award for Service to the Prevention Field

This award is given in memory of **Maggie Marcopul**, an extraordinary person and prevention professional. She influenced the prevention field in Pennsylvania for more than three decades. Maggie served as a trainer, board member, officer, and advocate as part of the Pennsylvania Certification Board and the Commonwealth Prevention Alliance (CPA). She is greatly missed, but her work and impact endure.

### **Application Guidelines:**

- I. Nominee must be a current member of CPA. A list of CPA Members can be found at: <https://commonwealthpreventionalliance.org/membership/current-membership-listing/>
- II. To renew membership or become a CPA member, please go to the About Membership Page, of the CPA website, scroll to the bottom and click the appropriate link: <https://commonwealthpreventionalliance.org/membership/about-cpa-membership/>
- III. Nominee must exhibit professionalism, values and a commitment to the field; consistent with the memory of Maggie Marcopul.
- IV. Nominee must have a minimum five (5) years of experience in the prevention field and currently working in Pennsylvania.
- V. The nomination deadline is **April 12, 2021** (*CPA reserves the right to extend the deadline*).
- VI. **The Nominator will be asked to briefly answer the following questions. Please keep all responses to 150 words or less.**
  - a. How has the nominee made a contribution to prevention through the following 4 areas? (*150 words or less for each area*)  
**Service, Leadership, Advocacy, and Education**
  - b. What is a potential short-term impact of the nominee's prevention efforts?
  - c. What is a potential long-term impact of the nominee's prevention efforts?
- VII. Current CPA Board of Directors are ineligible to nominate or be nominated.

March/April 2021 - Application review panel will be assembled

- Panel will consist of CPA Board of Directors (*If a conflict of interest occurs with any member of the review panel, they will be step down and a replacement selected*)

March 15, 2021– Maggie Marcopul application opens

- Application review process will occur
- Award winner will be selected by review panel, presented, and approved by the CPA Board of Directors

April 26, 2021 - Winner will be notified (week of 4/26)

- All nominators will also be notified via email
- A CPA representative will contact winner and provide more details and direction

June 17, 2021 – Winner Recognition

- We will request an acceptance video (more details to follow)
- If winner has already registered for the CPA conference, a refund will be issued
