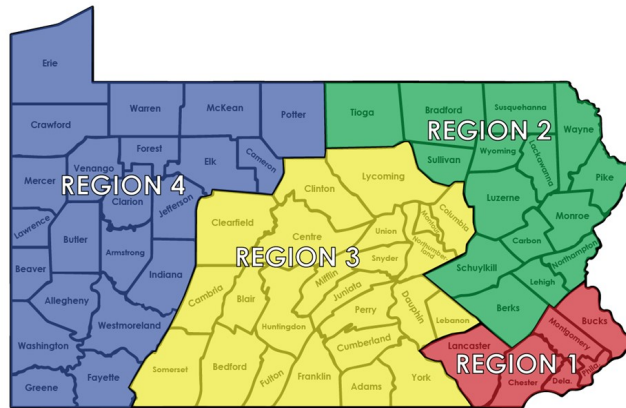


## Board of Director Details
